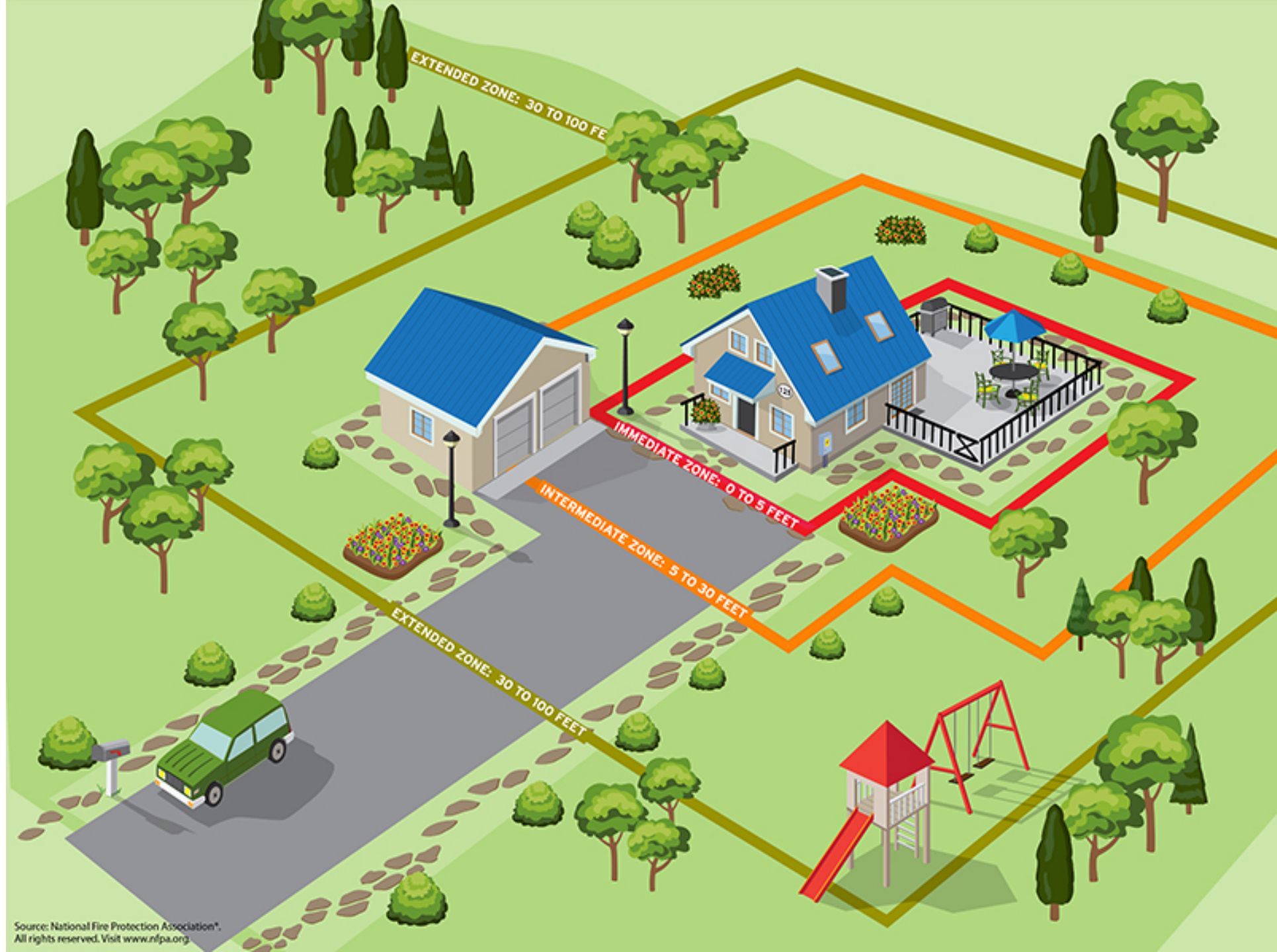

What is Firewise

- Recognition Program that empowers communities to reduce wildfire risk in the Wildland Urban Interface

Purpose

- Wildfire Risk is Shared Risk to Life and Property
- Firewise is the Platform For Addressing this Risk
- Building Community – Becoming Fire Adapted
- Why is this important in La Pine?



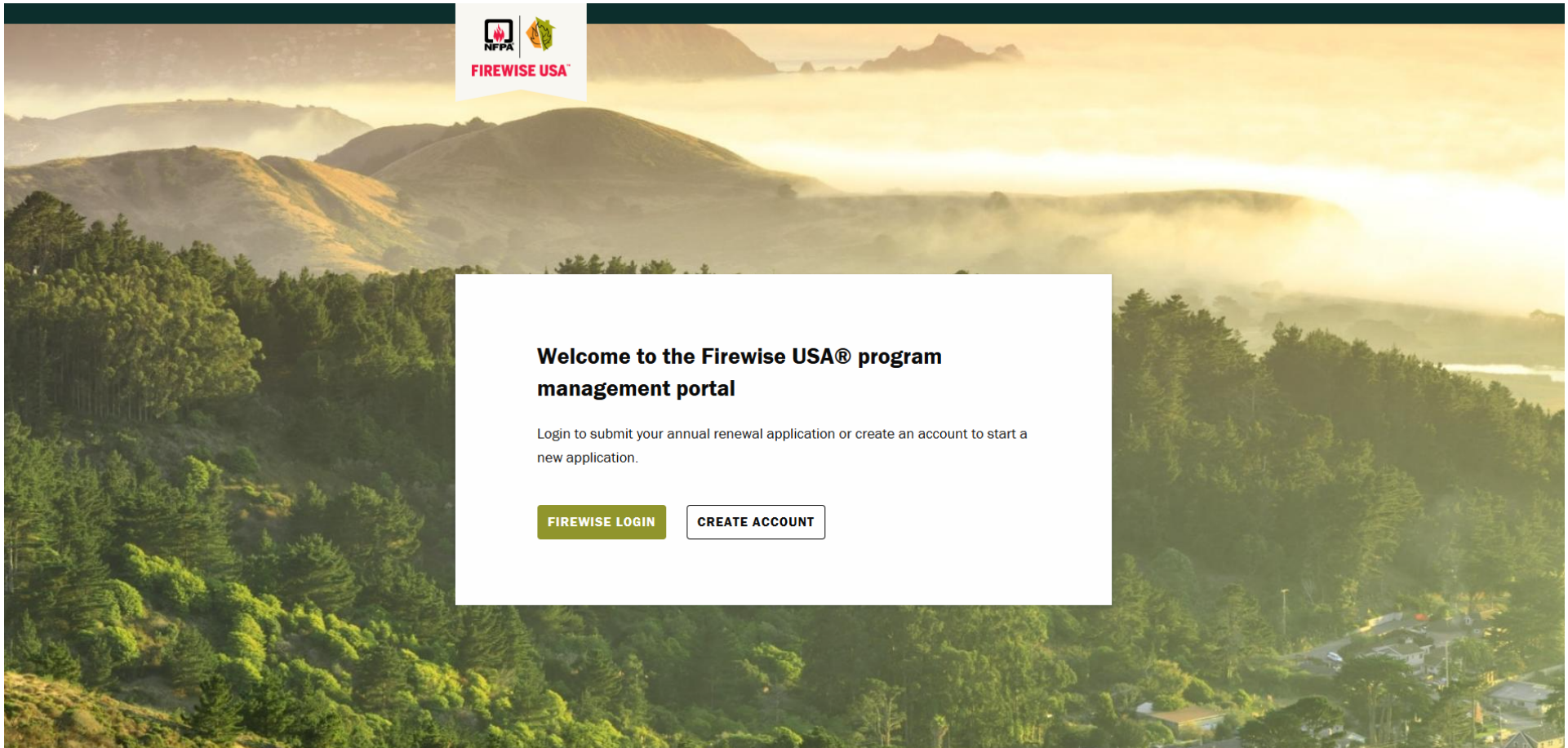
Requirements

- 8 Residences Minimum
- Must Show Annual Investment
 - Hours of labor
 - Invoices from Contractors
- Have an annual Firewise Day

Getting Started

- Form a Firewise Committee
- Pick a Resident Leader
- Schedule Community Risk Assessment
- Capture themes from Assessment in Document
- Develop Action Plan

Getting Started

- Complete 9 step application process in the Firewise Portal
- Approval Recognition

Maintaining Recognition

- Update Community Risk Assessment every 5 Years
- Update Action Plan every 3 Years
- Track Investment
- Annual Firewise Day
- Build Community (Relationships)
